What Days' Supply Coverage is Available?

Both 30-day and 90-day fills are possible, however, 90-days fills will not be available at our $\times 2.5$ co-pay benefit structure, instead they will be $\times 3$ \$25 for a total of \$75

Where is it Available?

\$25 Insulins will be available through both Mail and any network Retail channel pharmacies

Which Insulins are Covered?

Preferred Brand Name Insulins on the ESI National Preferred Formulary, currently this includes: Humalog, Humulin, Lantus & Levemir

Note: Additional Insulins may be added by the end of August as negotiations are still ongoing

Which Insulins are Not Covered?

All Non-Preferred Brand Name Insulins not on the ESI National Preferred Formulary will remain subject to the Non-Preferred Brand Name Co-Pay and Brand Name Deductible. All excluded Insulins will continue to be excluded, this includes the following Insulins: Admelog, Afrezza, Apidra, Basaglar, Exubera, Fiasp, Novolin, Novolog & Ryzodeg. Additionally, while Toujeo & Tresiba are on the National Preferred Formulary, they are not part of this new benefit and will continue to be covered at the regular Preferred Brand Name Co-Pay and be subject to the Brand Name Deductible
